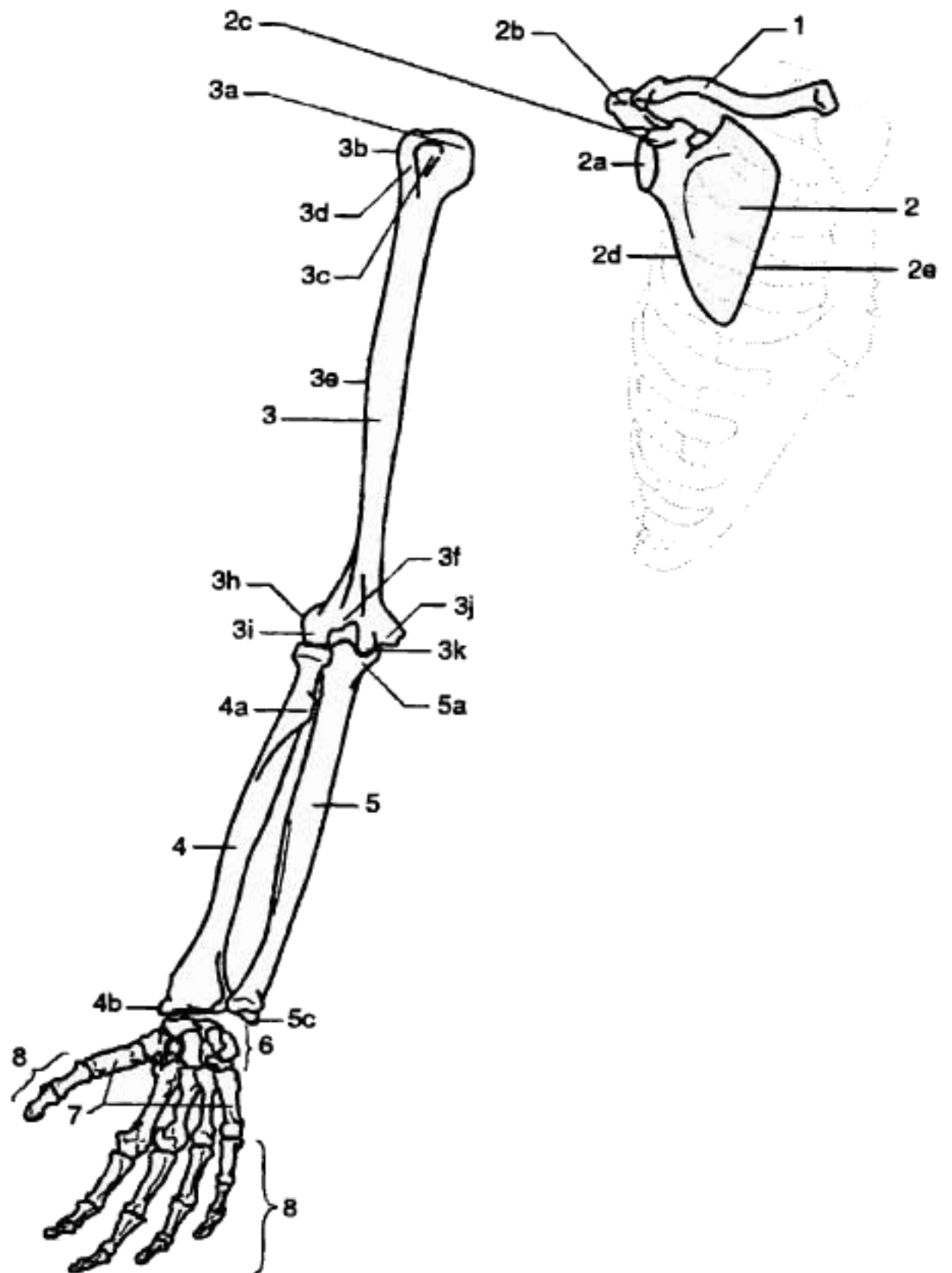


Figure 6.11a. Anterior view of pectoral girdle and upper arm.
