The key defines three types of electrode placements on a spinal cord cross-section:

- Red line:** A red line indicates an electrode placed on the dorsal (back) surface of the spinal cord.
- Grey line:** A grey line indicates an electrode placed on the ventral (front) surface of the spinal cord.
- Black line:** A black line indicates an electrode placed on the lateral (side) surface of the spinal cord.

The three diagrams below the key show the relative positions of these electrode types on the spinal cord cross-section.
